 - (1) The Saint at Hebron (Jacob to Israel)
 - (a) Supplanter to Prince of God 32:1-35:29.
 - (i) Met with angels of God.
 - (ii) Jacob sends messengers to Esau.
 - (iii) Prayer to God.
 - (iv) Gifts sent to Esau.
 - (v) Wrestled with God name changed from Jacob to Israel (He who strives with God).
 - (vi) Jacob's power is not with his mind but henceforth only from God. Jacob injured in struggle (hip dislocated) and he limped as a continual reminder of this occasion.
 - (vii) Humbles before Esau.
 - (viii) Esau never greedy for more than he needed.
 - (ix) Jacob settles.
 - (x) Dinah defiled; Simeon and Levi inflict cruelty on Shechem.
 - (xi) God sends Jacob to Bethel.
 - (xii) Journey to Hebron (Joseph born en route).
 - (xiii) Reuben lay with Bilhah and Israel heard of it.
