 - g. Joseph's Life (Continued)
 - (3) The Provident Sovereign 41:37-50:26.
 - (a) Joseph Exalted (Age 30) 41:38-57.
 - (i) Appointed "prime minister" over all Egypt.
 - (ii) Marriage to Asenath, daughter of Potiphera.
 - (iii) Seven Years of Plenty.
 - (iv) Two Sons: Manassah "Making me to forget". Ephraim – "Fruitful".
 - (v) Famine arrives.
 - (b) Joseph's Brothers go to Egypt *42:1-28.*
 - (i) Jacob sends 10 sons to Egypt to buy grain.
 - (ii) Meet Joseph accused as spies.
 - (iii) Joseph releases them; gives them grain; returns their money; keeps Simeon and demands they bring their youngest brother to him as proof of their honesty.
 - (c) Brothers Return to Canaan Jacob refuses to let Benjamin go to Egypt 42:28-38.
 - (d) Joseph's Brothers Return to Egypt 43:1-45:28.
 - (i) Famine severe, Jacob sends for more grain offering choice fruit, a present, double money and Benjamin.
 - (ii) Benjamin framed as a thief.
 - (iii) Joseph reveals his identity.
 - (iv) Pharaoh sends wagons for Jacob and family.
 - (v) Jacob learns Joseph alive.
