 4. Retirement to Bethsaida (From Capernaum to Bethsaida and Return)
 - o Teaches and Feeds 5,000 Men (*Mark 6:32-44*)
 - o Multitudes Seek to Make Him King, He Retires to Pray (*John 6:15*)
 - o Walks on Water and Stills the Storm (*John 6:16-24; Mark 6:45-51*)
 - o Discourse on "Bread of Life" (*John 6:25-59*)
