 2. To the Decapolis (From Borders of Tyre and Sidon to the Decapolis)
 - o Heals a Deaf Stammer *(Mark 7:31-37)*
 - o Feeds 4,000 Men *(Mark 8:1-9)*
 3. To Caesarea Philippi (From Decapolis to Dalmontha, Bethsaida, Caesarea Philippi)
 - o The Leaven of the Pharisees *(Mark 8:10-21)*
 - o Healing of Blind Man *(Mark 8:22-26)*
 - o Peter's Confession *(Matt. 16:13-20)*
 - o Teaching Concerning Cross *(Mark 8:31-9:1)*
 - o The Transfiguration *(Luke 9:28-36)*
 - o Restoration of Demoniac Boy *(Luke 9:37-43)*
 4. Last Return to Capernaum (From Caesarea Philippi to Capernaum)
 - o Teaching Concern True Greatness *(Mark 9:33-37)*
 - o The Unknown Wonder Worker *(Mark 9:38-50)*
